



#### The Problem of Hunger



- 40 million Americans are "food insecure"
- Definition insufficient access to enough food to live a healthy, active lifestyle
- That includes 12.5 million children
- 35 million tons of food thrown away annually

# Hunger in the QCA

- 1,042,852 people in the 23 counties we serve
- 105,830 are food insecure (pre-COVID)
- 10.1%
- 1 in 10 people
- Missing 17,910,200 meals per year



# Hunger Hurts the Most Vulnerable

- 230,240 children in our 23 counties
- 34,500 are food insecure (pre-COVID)
- 15%
- 1 in 7 children



## Why do we need the Foodbank?

- Food available in semi trucks
- Pantries can't take that
- We take the semi trucks and take orders by the case
- No donor wants 300 phone calls
- One call takes care of everything
- Assurance all the way through the process:
  - Legitimate use
  - Legal requirements
  - Non-discrimination
  - Food safety

Very low cost per meal



# Impact of COVID on Food Insecurity

- 105,830 159,848 are food insecure
- 10.1% 15.3%
- 1 in 10 1 in 7 people
- 34,500 55,575 children are food insecure
- 15% 24.1%
- 1 in 7 1 in 4 children
- Food insecurity is up over 50% since COVID





 1 in 7 people don't have enough food

1 in 4 children

 We are throwing away enough food to feed everyone

Every \$1 provides 5 meals
