
# People in the Quad Cities Need Food

40% of all the food produced is not consumed annually. It gets thrown away, even though in our area alone, **8.7% of Scott County** and **11.6% of Rock Island County** residents are food insecure.

How can we throw away so much of this valuable resource when so many people are in need? Hunger does not affect one type of person or one geographic location. Young or old. Rural or urban. Hunger affects **1 in 8 people** throughout the United States.
